



# Latino Outdoors THEORY OF CHANGE

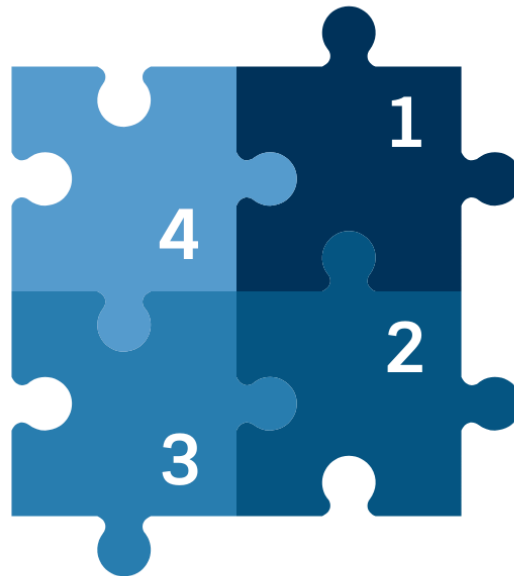
Latino Outdoors offers free outdoor activities and supports people who are receiving their introduction to nature by creating a welcoming and family-friendly environment.
